Course Description: OT Analysis and Group Process 108, Ethical Practice, is a 1-hour course designed for all clinicians. The American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA) Code of Ethics is a “statement of principles used to promote and maintain high standards of conduct” in all occupational therapy practice and it is imperative to have an understanding of ethics in order to carrying out one’s professional responsibilities. This lesson will provide a description of ethical theory and outline the ethical decision-making process. Principles of the AOTA Code of Ethics will be explored and emphasized. Case scenarios will be used to highlight and enforce learning of the ethical concepts.
